Beginning with Section 4, an overview is provided of the IIG for each association, along with the substantive assessment of the respective application.

2. Working method

General

The IIG aims to promote internationalization and inclusion amongst existing student associations. Each organization may request a sum of no more than €1,000. The total funding available for the grant in 2023 has been set at €15,000. As shown in the overview of applications, the amount of grant funding requested substantially exceeds the total funding available for the grant. The CUOS has sought to honour as many grant applications as possible in whole or in part, but, in accordance with Article 4(4) of the Regulations for the Internationalization and Inclusion Grant (hereinafter: the Regulations), it retains the policy discretion to determine which applications are most eligible for the grant.

The working method of the CUOS is in accordance with the CUOS Regulations and the Regulations for the Internationalization and Inclusion Grant. This provisional decision stems from the CUOS task of reviewing associations seeking eligibility for the IIG. Each association will receive a letter containing the provisional decision after the publication of this document. The CUOS shall give the association the opportunity to take note of the proposed decision and express a view within 10 working days, in accordance with Article 9(4) of the Regulations. If the association concerned does make its views known within this period, CUOS will make a definitive decision, and the association will receive a new decision as soon as possible thereafter. If no views are made known, the provisional decision shall become the final decision by operation of law.

Accountability for the activities for which grant has been awarded shall proceed in accordance with Article 10 of the Regulations.

Deadline

As in the previous year, associations could apply for inclusion until 23:59 on 31 March 2023. This deadline was set to provide associations with additional time after the deadline for activity grants and housing, which was set for 1 February. In the first weeks after the deadline, any additional documents were collected, after which the applications were in terms of their substance. After considering a complete application, the provisional decision is communicated to the association.

Assessment

The application is assessed by the CUOS on the following points, to be found in Article 7 of the Regulations: content; purpose; target group and scope; approach; PR plan; amount and feasibility; possibility of the association acquiring its own income; and the relationship between the request and the association's own budget. In addition to these substantive assessment criteria, and in accordance with Article 8 of the Regulations, several weighting factors are included in the assessment: diversity in the range of activities, support base, contribution to academic development, and how the plan fits in with University policy. The main weighting factor is whether the activity contributes to the integration and inclusion of international and Dutch students.

Furthermore, as in the previous year, and in accordance with Article 3 of the Regulations, CUOS takes into account the financial need of the applications. Amounts requested for an activity whose main purpose is food and beverages or for general advertising material are awarded only in half, in accordance with Article 3(3). Moreover, given the grant ceiling and Article 4(4), the CUOS has also awarded all food and beverages expenses from other activities (substantive or otherwise) only in half. Pursuant to Article 3(4), the CUOS has also not granted any subsidy for alcoholic beverages this year, and applications that are intended purely for funding alcoholic beverages have been rejected. With regard to professional translations, the CUOS will fully reimburse the translation of essential documents (including statutes), while the translation of non-essential documents (e.g., internal regulations) will not be reimbursed.

Association

The African Students Community Groningen (ASC):

- has requested €1000 for this year;
- has submitted its application in time and in full.

Assessment for the Internationalization and Inclusion Grant

The CUOS has assessed that the ASC:

- DOES meet the general conditions;
- HAS sufficiently demonstrated the extent to which the association is internationalized at this time;
- HAS requested the grant for projects or activities that are eligible for subsidy and that make a sufficient contribution to the internationalization of student associations and/or the inclusion of international (and other) students in Groningen;
- HAS demonstrated a financial need for support from the CUOS.

Decision on the Internationalization and Inclusion Grant

The CUOS has decided to award €700 to the ASC for 2023. The CUOS is allocating this amount for the purpose of organizing the international dinner and the symposium. The CUOS stipulates the condition that the amount may not be spent on alcoholic beverages. The CUOS notes that the ASC should prepare a better cost specification in the future.

4.2 AEGEE

- HAS requested the grant for projects or activities that are eligible for subsidy and that make a sufficient contribution to the internationalization of student associations and/or the inclusion of international (and other) students in Groningen;
- HAS demonstrated a financial need for support from the CUOS.

Decision on the Internationalization and Inclusion Grant

The CUOS has decided to award €400.50 to AEGEE for 2023. The CUOS is allocating this amount for the purpose of the Europe Week and the Conference. The CUOS stipulates the condition that the amount may not be spent on alcoholic beverages.

4.3 Clio

Association

The Study Association of International Relations & International Organization (Clio):

- has requested €500 for this year;
- has submitted its application in time and in full.

Assessment for the Internationalization and Inclusion Grant

The CUOS has assessed that Clio:

- DOES meet the general conditions
- HAS sufficiently demonstrated the extent to which the association is internationalized at this time;
- HAS requested the grant for projects or activities that are eligible for subsidy and that make a sufficient contribution to the internationalization of student associations and/or the inclusion of international (and other) students in Groningen;
- HAS demonstrated a financial need for support from the CUOS.

Decision on the Internationalization and Inclusion Grant

The CUOS has decided to award €500 to the Clio for 2023. The CUOS is allocating this amount for the purpose of organizing the international dinner. The CUOS stipulates the condition that the amount may not be spent on alcoholic beverages. The CUOS is further allocating no more than 50% of the requested amounts for food and beverages, in accordance with Article 3(3) of the Regulations for the Internationalization and Inclusion Grant.

4.4 Commotie

Association

The Study Association Commotie:

- has requested €113.73 for this year;
- has submitted its application in time and in full.

Assessment for the Internationalization and Inclusion Grant

The CUOS has assessed that Commotie:

- DOES meet the general conditions
- HAS sufficiently demonstrated the extent to which the association is internationalized at this time;
- HAS requested the grant for projects or activities that are eligible for subsidy and that make a sufficient contribution to the internationalization of student associations and/or the inclusion of international (and other) students in Groningen;
- HAS demonstrated a financial need for support from the CUOS.

Decision on the Internationalization and Inclusion Grant

The CUOS has decided to award €113.73 to Commotie for 2023. The CUOS is allocating this amount for the purpose of the pride stickers and the dance activity.

4.5 Cover

Association

The study association for Artificial Intelligence and Computing Science (Cover):

- has requested €996 for this year;
- has submitted its application in time and in full.

Assessment for the Internationalization and Inclusion Grant

The CUOS has assessed that Cover:

- DOES meet the general conditions
- HAS sufficiently demonstrated the extent to which the association is internationalized at this time;
- HAS NOT requested the subsidy for projects or activities that are eligible for subsidy and that make a sufficient contribution to the internationalization of student associations and/or the inclusion of international (and other) students in Groningen;
- HAS demonstrated a financial need for support from the CUOS.

Decision on the Internationalization and Inclusion Grant

The CUOS has decided to allocate no subsidy (€0) to Cover for 2023, given that the boating activity is a regular activity and that is not of a specifically internationalizing or inclusive character. In this regard, the CUOS refers to Articles 7 and 8 of the Regulations.

4.6 DSLA

Association

The Decentralized Student Association (DSLAs):

- has requested €973 for this year;
- has submitted its application in time and in full.

Assessment for the Internationalization and Inclusion Grant

The CUOS has assessed that the DSLAs:

- DOES meet the general conditions
- HAS sufficiently demonstrated the extent to which the association is internationalized at this time;
- HAS requested the grant for projects or activities that are eligible for subsidy and that make a sufficient contribution to the internationalization of student associations and/or the inclusion of international (and other) students in Groningen;
- HAS demonstrated a financial need for support from the CUOS.

Decision on the Internationalization and Inclusion Grant

The CUOS has decided to award €150 to the DSLAs for 2023. The CUOS is allocating this amount for the costs of the venue for the panel discussion. The application for the trip to Vienna, the trip to The Hague, and the International Blog has been rejected, as these are regular activities, and they are not of a specifically internationalizing or inclusive character. In this regard, the CUOS refers to Article 7 of the Regulations for the Internationalization and Inclusion Grant.

4.7 EBF

Association

The Economics and Business Faculty association (EBF):

- has requested €450 for this year;
- has submitted its application in time and in full.

Assessment for the Internationalization and Inclusion Grant

The CUOS has assessed that EBF:

- DOES meet the general conditions
- HAS sufficiently demonstrated the extent to which the association is internationalized at this time;
- HAS requested the grant for projects or activities that are eligible for subsidy and that make a sufficient contribution to the internationalization of student associations and/or the inclusion of international (and other) students in Groningen;
- HAS demonstrated a financial need for support from the CUOS.

Decision on the Internationalization and Inclusion Grant

The CUOS has decided to award €450 to the EBF for 2023. The CUOS is allocating this amount for the purpose of the Diversity Week.

4.8 ELSA

Association

The European Law Students' Association (ELSA):

- has requested €1000 for this year;
- has submitted its application in time, but not in full.

Decision on the Internationalization and Inclusion Grant

The CUOS has decided to declare the application from ELSA inadmissible, due to the timely but incomplete submission of the request. After multiple reminders from the CUOS, ELSA has not proven capable of submitting a complete application to the CUOS. The CUOS was thus compelled not to consider the application.

4.9 Enactus

Association

The foundation Enactus:

- has requested €500 for this year;
- has submitted its application in time and in full.

Assessment for the Internationalization and Inclusion Grant

The CUOS has assessed that the Enactus:

- DOES meet the general conditions
- HAS sufficiently demonstrated the extent to which the association is internationalized at this time;
- HAS requested the grant for projects or activities that are eligible for subsidy and that make a sufficient contribution to the internationalization of student associations and/or the inclusion of international (and other) students in Groningen;
- HAS demonstrated a financial need for support from the CUOS.

Decision on the Internationalization and Inclusion Grant

The CUOS has decided to award €440 to Enactus for 2023. The CUOS is allocating this amount for the purpose of the Integration-stimulating workshops, with 50% of the budgeted amount intended for general promotion, in accordance with Article 3.3 of the Regulations for the Internationalization and Inclusion Grant.

4.10 EPU

Association

The association E Pluribus Unum (EPU):

- has requested €142.68 for this year;
- has submitted its application in time and in full.

Assessment for the Internationalization and Inclusion Grant

The CUOS has assessed that EPU:

- DOES meet the general conditions
- HAS sufficiently demonstrated the extent to which the association is internationalized at this time;
- HAS requested the grant for projects or activities that are eligible for subsidy and that make a sufficient contribution to the internationalization of student associations and/or the inclusion of international (and other) students in Groningen;
- HAS demonstrated a financial need for support from the CUOS.

Decision on the Internationalization and Inclusion Grant

The CUOS has decided to award €142.68 to EPU for 2023. The CUOS is allocating this amount for the purpose of the pride flag and pride stickers.

4.11 ESN

The Erasmus Student Network (ESN):

Assessment for the Internationalization and Inclusion Grant

The CUOS has assessed that the ESN:

- DOES meet the general conditions
- HAS sufficiently demonstrated the extent to which the association is internationalized at this time;
- HAS requested the grant for projects or activities that are eligible for subsidy and that make a sufficient contribution to the internationalization of student associations and/or the inclusion of international (and other) students in Groningen;
- HAS demonstrated a financial need for support from the CUOS.

Decision on the Internationalization and Inclusion Grant

The CUOS has decided to award €627.60 to ESN for 2023. The CUOS is allocating this amount for the purpose of the Integration Night. The CUOS does not allocate any funds for the purpose of alcoholic beverages, in accordance with Article 3(4) of the Regulations for the Internationalization and Inclusion Grant. The CUOS is further allocating no more than 50% of the requested amounts for food and beverages, in accordance with Article 3(3) of the Regulations for the Internationalization and Inclusion Grant. The ESN is organizing the Integration Night in collaboration with SOG, AEGEE and SIB. The ESN retains ultimate responsibility for delivering the accountability.

4.12 Esperia

- HAS sufficiently demonstrated the extent to which the association is internationalized at this time;
- HAS requested the grant for projects or activities that are eligible for subsidy and that make a sufficient contribution to the internationalization of student associations and/or the inclusion of international (and other) students in Groningen;
- HAS demonstrated a financial need for support from the CUOS.

Decision on the Internationalization and Inclusion Grant

The CUOS has decided to award €402.93 to Bragi for 2023. The CUOS is allocating this amount for the purpose of producing flyers, posters, and a banner in English. The CUOS will fund 50% of general promotion, in accordance with Article 3.3 of the Regulations for the Internationalization and Inclusion Grant. The CUOS has decided not to allocate any subsidy for the Rehearsal Weekend, given that it is a regular activity and that it is not of a specifically internationalizing or inclusive character, as referred to in the Regulations for the Internationalization and Inclusion Grant. In this regard, the CUOS refers to Articles 7 and 8 of the Regulations.

4.15 GFE

The Groninger Fiscale Eenheid (GFE):

Assessment for the Internationalization and Inclusion Grant

The CUOS has assessed that GFE:

- DOES meet the general conditions

- HAS requested the grant for projects or activities that are eligible for subsidy and that make a sufficient contribution to the internationalization of student associations and/or the inclusion of international (and other) students in Groningen;
- HAS demonstrated a financial need for support from the CUOS.

Decision on the Internationalization and Inclusion Grant

The CUOS has decided to award €242.25 to the GFE for 2023. The CUOS is allocating this amount for the purpose of the Femme Fiscale. The CUOS does not allocate any funds for the purpose of alcoholic beverages, in accordance with Article 3(4) of the Regulations for the Internationalization and Inclusion Grant. The CUOS is further allocating no more than 50% of the requested amounts for food and beverages.

The CUOS has decided to award €180.43 to Ubbo Emmius for 2023. The CUOS is allocating this amount for the purpose of the pride flag and pride stickers.

The CUOS has decided to award €290 to Idun for 2023. The CUOS is allocating this amount for the purpose of the LGBTQIA+ Idun stickers and the Cultural Market. The CUOS stipulates the condition that the amount may not be spent on alcoholic beverages.

Assessment for the Internationalization and Inclusion Grant

The CUOS has assessed that De Golfbreker:

- DOES meet the general conditions
- HAS sufficiently demonstrated the extent to which the association is internationalized at this time;
- HAS requested the grant for projects or activities that are eligible for subsidy and that make a sufficient contribution to the internationalization of student associations and/or the inclusion of international (and other) students in Groningen;
- HAS demonstrated a financial need for support from the CUOS.

Decision on the Internationalization and Inclusion Grant

The CUOS has decided to award €400 to De Golfbreker for 2023. The CUOS is allocating this amount for the purpose of the English-language Club Magazine and the Code Blauw information nights. The CUOS has decided not to allocate any subsidy for the Boxing Clinic, given that it is not of an internationalizing or inclusive character and that it does not seek to promote contact between diverse groups, as referred to in the Regulations for the Internationalization and Inclusion Grant. In this regard, the CUOS refers to Articles 7 and 8 of the Regulations.

4.19 Groene Uilen-Moestasj

Association

The association de Groene Uilen-Moestasj:

- has requested €1000 for this year;
- has submitted its application in time and in full.

Assessment for the Internationalization and Inclusion Grant The

CUOS has assessed that de Groene Uilen-Moestasj:

- DOES meet the general conditions
- HAS sufficiently demonstrated the extent to which the association is internationalized at this time;
- HAS NOT requested the subsidy for projects or activities that are eligible for subsidy and that make a sufficient contribution to the internationalization of student associations and/or the inclusion of international (and other) students in Groningen;
- HAS demonstrated a financial need for support from the CUOS.

Decision on the Internationalization and Inclusion Grant

The CUOS has decided not to allocate any (€0) subsidy to de Groene Uilen-Moestasj for 2023, given that the activities are not of an internationalizing or inclusive character, as referred to in the Regulations for the Internationalization and Inclusion Grant. The CUOS does not allocate any subsidy for activity prizes, given that the CUOS does not allocate any subsidy for the compensation (financial or otherwise) of members. In this regard, the CUOS refers to Articles 7 and 8 of the Regulations.

4.20 Groninger Studenten Alpenclub

Association

The Groninger Studenten Alpenclub (GSAC):

- has requested €402.90 for this year;
- has submitted its application in time and in full.

Assessment for the Internationalization and Inclusion Grant

The CUOS has assessed that the GSAC:

- HAS sufficiently demonstrated the extent to which the association is internationalized at this time;
- HAS NOT requested the subsidy for projects or activities that are eligible for subsidy and that make a sufficient contribution to the internationalization of student associations and/or the inclusion of international (and other) students in Groningen;
- HAS demonstrated a financial need for support from the CUOS.

Decision on the Internationalization and Inclusion Grant

The CUOS has decided not to allocate any (€0) subsidy to GSAC for 2023 for the translation of the internal regulations, given that the CUOS does not allocate any subsidy for the translation of non-essential documents, in accordance with Article 3(4) of the Regulations for the Internationalization and Inclusion Grant.

4.21 GSb

The Groningen Students' Union (GSb):
