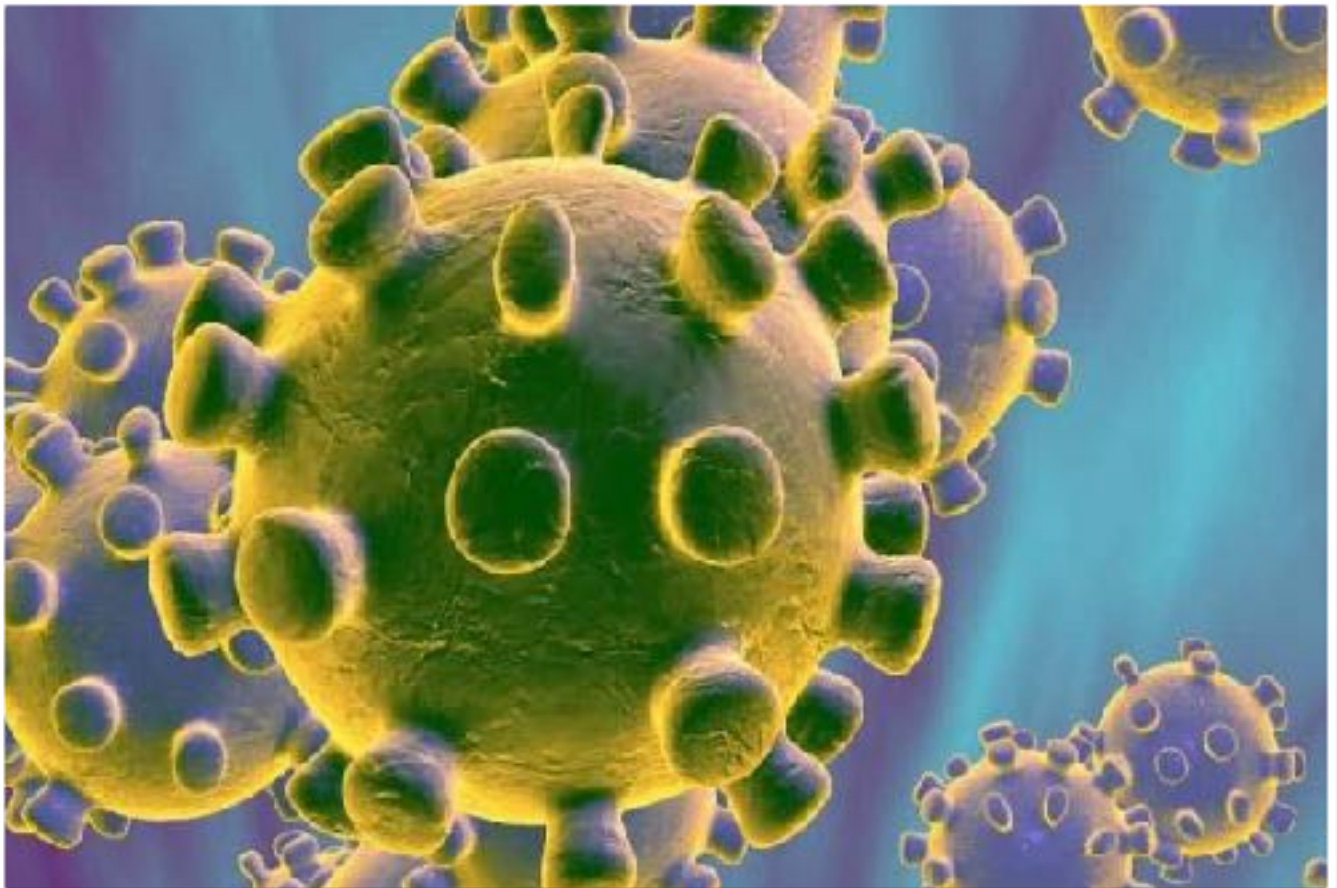


COVID-19: What can the humanities do?
