This two-year programme gives you the skills to analyse complex arguments and problems, and the ability to present ideas in a clear and rigorous manner. It prepares you to do a PhD in philosophy and provides expertise for other jobs where research skills are needed such as think tank, consultancy and journalism. With our flexible curriculum you can pursue your own research interest.

- Choose one of three specializations: history of philosophy, theoretical philosophy, or ethics, social and political philosophy
- Receive training in academic English; improve your skills in writing, presenting and networking in an academic community
- Personal supervision and mentoring in a friendly environment
- Study at a faculty with internationally renowned staff and students from around the world
- Prospective positions available as paid teaching assistant
- The programme offers opportunities for a study abroad semester at partner universities
