# 3. For information/received documents

## a. Update PC's:

Best Teaching Practice Award (BTPA): PC members have voted on the nominees. However, PCs were confused how to judge the nominees as they didn't know the courses. Pro Geo would like to know what the vision behind this procedure was.

Van den Assem explains that the organization of the first BTPA did not work as voters had difficulty recognizing best practices and the voting was planned halfway the year. Therefore, this year the procedure had been changed. A list of really best practices had been composed by the student assessor, the Director of Education and Van den Assem. Sadly, also this year there were problems. So, the student assessor will contact Pro Geo for improving the procedure. Also, any suggestions for improvement are welcome.

For FSS, the BTPA is a showcase to the rest of the University.

# b. Update Faculty Board:

- The HGP-programme is part of the university accreditation in June/July.
- A new teaching-oriented programme/track is in process.

- Continuing University discussions on internationalization.
- New research projects at the faculty will start with new positions in the upcoming period.
- A new form for the R&D interviews has been developed with more focus on merit and a personal development plan.
- Starter and incentive grants (Starters en stimuleringsbeurzen): A national discussion about these grants is going on. The Minister has reversed his plans. There is a lot of political debate. To be continued.
- c. Cost cutting and work pressure document: see bullet above. After revision with comments from the FC the document will be sent to the rest of the staff.
- d. Report Administrative Meeting autumn FSS: no comments.
- e. University Elections 2024 student section: Pro Geo has not received this email. [action Van der Ploeg to check].
- f. Concept minutes 12 December 2023:

## 4. Draft-proposal for the 'Designing Spatial Transformations' track

The proposal has already been discussed in the PC and there has been a survey among students with many interested responses. Expectation: 25-40 students.

## 5. Input from Pro Geo & Bursary PhD

Pro Geo: Pro Geo had a meeting with Terry van Dijk to prepare for carrying out their action point. It is possible for students to do a design project. Also, a yearly Design Challenge and two bachelor projects are towards design. Pro Geo is still being involved in this and is also busy with organizing a design panel to get new ideas. To be continued.

### 6. Input from staff

Request Study Advice involvement when changing programmes:

Following changes in the HGP programme, Study Advice has requested to be more and in an earlier stage being involved to bring in expertise when programmes will be changed. There have been implemented some changes in the bachelor programme concerning IAR and MAR. Study Advice has raised concerns that not enough has been done to counter study delay of students when they do not pass MAR (which is necessary to continue with IAR). Van den Assem and the Director of Education are aware of this. Study Advice wants to make sure that when programmes change, Study Advice will be involved because they have a good overview of what the consequences for students will be. This is also applicable for the international office.

Van den Assem and the Director of Education agree.
