

#### Appendix 4: Transitional arrangement for History of International Relations

History of International relations (10 ects, sem Ib) > History of International Relations I (5 ects, sem Ia) + History of International Relations II (5 ects, sem Ib)

Cohort 2018/2019:

Cohort 2017/2018 and any earlier

Situation #1: student did not meet the 80% attendance requirement in HIR during the academic year 2017/2018 => the student follows the new set-up, i.e. History of International Relations I AND History of International Relations II.

Situation #2: student did not participate in HIR during the academic year 2017/2018 => the student follows the new set-up, i.e. History of International Relations I AND History of International Relations II.

Situation #3: student met the 80% attendance requirement AND received a 4.5 or higher on each of the two exams, including the resits, BUT had an average exam grade below 5.5 (all in the academic year 2017/2018) => the student is offered a one-off possibility to retake the one exam with the lowest score at a communicated date. In case the student fails the one-off retake, the student follows the new set-up, i.e. History of International Relations I AND History of International Relations II.
