

Short Biography Bernd Seifert, LL.M.

Bernd Seifert studied law at Bielefeld University. After passing his first state examination, he worked at this university for two years as a research associate. Having graduated as a fully qualified German lawyer in 1999, Bernd Seifert is now legal adviser and data protection officer at the Chamber of Industry and Commerce (IHK) in Oldenburg. He also is a lecturer in commercial law at Carl von Ossietzky Universität Oldenburg and chairman of the advisory board of Hanse Law School.

In his capacity as a member of the permanent working group on European contract law at the Association of German Chambers of Commerce and Industry (Deutscher Industrie- und Handelskammertag – DIHK) in Berlin he took part as an expert in the public hearing on CESL held by the IMCO Committee of the European Parliament in September 2012.

Bernd Seifert has published a number of books and articles on various legal subjects such as German and European corporate law, competition law, data protection law, civil procedure law, insolvency law, Internet law, and commercial law.
