

Short Biography Dr. Charlotte Pavillon

After spending her childhood in France, Charlotte Pavillon studied international relations (MA, 2004) and law (LLM, 2005 cum laude) at the University of Groningen (the Netherlands), where she also read for her PhD. She defended her thesis titled 'Open normen in het Europees consumentenrecht' (Open norms in European consumer law) in 2011. During her doctoral studies, she was a visiting scholar at the University of Hull (United Kingdom). She was appointed a postdoctoral researcher at the Groningen Centre for Law and Governance in 2011. She lectured international relations and private law at the University of Groningen from 2002 to 2012 and joined the University of Leiden (the Netherlands) as an assistant professor in January 2013. She has published articles on the Unfair Contract Terms and Unfair Commercial Practices Directives, on construction law, civil procedural law and the private regulation of B2C-relationships.
