

Short Biography Prof.Dr.Dr.h.c. Norbert Reich

Prof. Dr. Dr. h.c. Norbert Reich is Emeritus Professor of Private law and European Economic Law at the University of Bremen, and is a renowned expert on European private law.

In 1973 Norbert Reich became a full Professor at the Hamburg University for Economics and Politics (HWP), from 1998-2002 at the Hamburg Law Faculty II (reformierte Juristenausbildung). From 1982 he was a Professor at the University of Bremen and from 2005 an Emeritus Professor. He also served as the managing director of the ZERP, the Centre of European Law and Politics at the University of Bremen from 1982-1991. In 2000 he received an honorary doctorate from Helsinki University and from 2001-2004 he was the Rector at the Riga Graduate School of Law. Besides being a Visiting Professor at Groningen, Norbert Reich holds visiting professorships at the Universities of Montpellier, Fribourg, Keele, Luzern and Tartu. Prof. Reich's other activities include several advisory activities in European Economic and Consumer Law.

During his appointment as Visiting Professor in the Centre for Law and Governance at the University of Groningen, Professor Norbert Reich has taught some classes on EU civil law. Within this period he also did research and a lecture on the 'Principles of European Private Law'.
