GOVERNANCE: ACTORS AND POLICIES

Governance = coordination, decision- and policymaking

- within a group of persons
- or within an institution
- or within a system of institutions
- = coordination of interests and objectives of diverse actors
- = policy-making with or without politics



GOVERNANCE ANALYSIS OF CESL

- INSTITUTIONAL dimension of governance
 - = not the specific focus of this workshop
- POLICY dimension

Focus of this workshop = consumer and business policy

 MULTI-LEVEL dimension of consumer and business policy
