

## Verlengd mondeling

<b>Algemeen</b>	Een verlengd mondeling is een verlenging van twee afgelegde tentamens en is uitsluitend bedoeld voor (zuivere eerstejaars) propedeuse studenten  NB. Het betreft dus geen zelfstandige tentamenkans. Een verlengd mondeling is overigens niet hetzelfde als een <a href="#">afwijkende tentamenregeling</a> .
<b>Doel</b>	Als u na een serieuze voorbereiding voor zowel voor het tentamen als het hertentamen net geen voldoende hebt behaald, dan krijgt u, middels het verlengd mondeling, de gelegenheid de examinatoren ervan te overtuigen dat u de tentamenstof wel op een voldoende niveau beheerst.
<b>Vorm</b>	Het verlengd mondeling wordt kort na het hertentamen afgenoem. De ondervraging wordt door twee docenten gedaan en duurt 15 minuten. Indien de examinatoren van oordeel zijn dat u de betreffende stof wel voldoende beheerst, wordt het cijfer van het hertentamen gewijzigd in een zes. Hoger is niet mogelijk! Overtuigt u de examinatoren niet, dan blijft de vijf behaald bij het hertentamen als cijfer staan.
<b>Voorwaarden</b>	Om in aanmerking te komen moet u aan <i>alle</i> onderstaande voorwaarden voldoen: <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• U bent in het <b>eerste jaar van uw inschrijving</b> of in het eerste jaar van een HBO-schakel/pre-masterprogramma en hebt één van de propedeusevakken gevuld waarvoor verlengd mondeling mogelijk is.</li><li>• U hebt in de <b>eerste tentamenkans minimaal een 4</b> en in de <b>tweede tentamenkans een 5</b> gehaald (in deze volgorde).</li></ul> Het beleid van het verlengd mondeling is stringent en op bovengenoemde voorwaarden bestaan geen uitzonderingen.
<b>Procedure</b>	Omdat het een verlenging betreft van de herkansing, kunt u zich niet hiervoor intekenen. Als u aan bovengenoemde voorwaarden voldoet dan ontvangt u op uw RUG e-mailadres uiterlijk drie dagen voorafgaand het verlengd mondeling meer informatie over de locatie, tijdstip etc.

## Extended oral resit examination

<b>General</b>	An extended oral resit examination is an extension of the two examination opportunities and is only available for students who are in their first year of registration (propaedeuse) for the LLB programme International and European Law. <b>Format</b>	The extended oral resit examination is held shortly after the resit examination. The interviewing and assessment will be conducted by two lecturers and takes 15 minutes. If the examiners are convinced that the student masters the subject matter sufficiently, the grade of the resit examination will be changed into a six (6). A higher grade is not possible! If the examiners are not convinced the student masters the subjects matter sufficiently, the grade five (5) obtained in the resit examination stands.
