WHAT IS FLEET MEDIA?


Fleet Media is an onboard service offering a large library of movies, TV box-sets, daily news and sports to passengers including:

Movies and TV box-sets

- Superior passenger entertainment service with a massive library of content
- Latest films at time of US DVD release
- Full box-sets of top TV series

News and sports

- Daily international news provided by Sky.
- Weekly news summary provided by Sky
- Daily international sports provided by Sky Updates depend on a stable reception of the satellite connection.



REQUIREMENTS BEFORE BOARDING

To make use of the Fleet Media entertainment system it is crucial to take the following precautions **before your trip**.

PC USER INTERFACE

If using a PC, the user will be required to have the following loaded on the computer in advance of boarding:

- Browser: Internet Explorer (IE) or Firefox
- Two plug-ins: Flash Player and Google Widevine Media Optimizer

Note: If either of the above requirements are not already installed, the user is automatically presented with links for the download. Follow the on-screen instructions to download.

Tablet or Smartphone user interface If using a smartphone or tablet, the user must first install the 'Fleet Media Player' from Google Play (Android) or App Store (iOS).



ADDITIONAL FEATURES

- Click on 'Recently Watched' to return to a programme.
- Click on 'Category' to browse offered categories.
- Type a title in the 'Search' field to quickly find a desired programme or movie.
- During play, you can stop or pause a programme at any time. When you return, it will begin playing within 30 seconds of the last played position.

TROUBLESHOOTING

I can't get connected to the onboard Wi-Fi

Check with the hotel manager onboard to ensure you are properly connected

I accidentally closed the programme window. How do I get back to it?

Click on 'Recently Watched' link to return to where you left off.

How do I know if a specific programme is offered?

Type the title or partial title into the 'Search' field.



TO CONNECT
