China Link Scholarship Application

China Link Scholarship is now open for application! Online application and all corresponding application documents should be submitted to China Scholarship Council on time.

Eligibility:

To be eligible, applicants must

- be a citizen of a country other than the People's Republic of China, and be in good health both mentally and physically;
- register as full-time student or employed as full-time academic staff at the home university by the time of application and throughout the proposed stay in China;
- be under 45 if applying for general scholar(for current undergraduates or postgraduates); be under 50 if applying for senior scholar(for current Ph.D candidates or faculties)
- meet the admission requirements of the applied universities in terms of academic ability, language proficiency and other relevant criteria.

Application Documents

- a) Passport Homepage and ID photo: Applicant shall submit a clear scanned copy of his/her ordinary passport with validity later than March 1, 2023. Applicants cannot provide valid passports before submitting may upload a scanned copy of identity certificates or official documents containing the applicants' "English name, Gender, Nationality, Date of Birth" and other information instead.
- b) Recommendation letter: Applicants must submit one recommendation letter from either home university or Chinese host university.
- c) Pre-admission documents. Applicants must provide pre-admission documents with official seal issued by one Chinese host university. Pre-admission letter issued by international students admission office or invitation letter from the school or professors are both acceptable. The documents should contain the following information:
 - 1) basic information of applicant: full name, nationality, current university;
 - 2) student category: general scholar or senior scholar;
 - 3) estimated study period: 1 month to 12 months between September 1st, 2023 and August 31th 2024;
 - 4) working language: Chinese or English
- d) Transcript of Current Education: If not applicable, please upload a school letter or employment letter issued by your home university.
- e) Personal Statement or Research Proposal in Chinese or English, with 500 words or

so.

- f) Applicants planning to stay in China for more than 6 months must submit a photocopy of the Foreigner Physical Examination Form completed in English or Chinese (blank form in *Appendix 3*). For applicants staying in China less than 6 months or if the report cannot be obtained due to time limits, a template of personal health statement in *Appendix 4* could be uploaded as an alternative one.
- g) Applicants planning to stay in China for more than 6 months must submit a photocopy of the non-criminal records report issued by a public authority of his or her current residence. For applicants staying in China less than 6 months or if the report cannot be obtained due to time limits, a template of non-criminal records affirmation in *Appendix 5* could be uploaded as an alternative one.
- h) Honors and Awards (optional)
- i) Papers or Articles Published (optional)
- j) Language qualification certificates (optional)
- k) Other Supporting Documents (optional)
- l) Works of Art (only applicable to art or design related majors)

Reminder: Each supporting document must be clear and valid with a maximum size of 3M. Applicants are recommended to use professional device to scan the relevant documents. Applicants shall bear the consequences caused by unclear or unidentifiable uploaded materials.
