Bernoulli Institute for Mathematics, Computer Science and Artificial Intelligence	<ul> <li>Prof. Davide Grossi (Bernoulli Institute) has been awarded a Horizon Europe grant of EUR 3.3 million for improving online participation platforms. This involves open source software that can be used at multiple levels of government: from local to national and transnational.</li> <li>Dr. Oliver Lorscheid and Prof.dr. Cecilia Salgado have both been awarded a Von Neumann Fellowship at the Institute for Advanced Study (IAS) in Princeton. Each year, about eight leading mid-career mathematicians and theoretical computer scientists receive the Von Neumann Fellowship. In total, the IAS yearly welcomes over 250 postdoctoral researchers and scholars from around the world.</li> </ul>			
Engineering and Technology Institute Groningen (ENTEG)	<ul> <li>Professors Michele Cucuzzella and Ming Cao will play a key role in the newly funded ChangeAble research consortium, which recently received €2.9 million from the Dutch Research Council (NWO). The research programme, 'Behavioural Insights for Climate Policy,' aims to make climate policy more effective and easier to implement.</li> </ul>			
Groningen Research Institute of Pharmacy (GRIP)	<ul> <li>Four GRIP researchers: Reinoud Gosens, Luke van der Koog, Anika Nagelkerke and Erik Frijlink, have been awarded a €200k Biotech Booster grant to develop a protein that promotes regeneration of alveolar epithelial cells and lung tissue into a biopharmaceutical for the treatment of Chronic Obstructive Pulmonary Disease.</li> <li>Dr. Kristina Haslinger has been awarded an NWO Vidi 2023 grant on her proposal to investigate a Microbial biosynthetic platform for ARomatic MerOTerpenoids (MARMOT).</li> </ul>

#### Updates from PostdocNL

Promovendi Netwerk Nederland (PNN) national study on the factors that contribute to PhD delays

This study is also aimed at recent PhD graduates which is why we distribute the study to postdoc networks.

Background and purpose of the study

Currently, the average PhD candidate takes approximately five years to complete their dissertation, even though most contracts end after four years. This often leaves candidates finishing their research in their own time, sometimes while managing other jobs or even unemployment.

### Focus group discussions

To investigate the factors that influence the duration of PhD trajectories, we will conduct a qualitative study. In October 2024, we will hold focus group discussions with PhD candidates in the final stages of their trajectories and recent alumni from all Dutch universities, university medical centers (UMCs), and research institutions. These sessions will focus on their experiences with completing their PhDs and the factors that have impacted this process. Our aim is to better understand what leads to successful completion of a PhD project and how to prevent delays.

### Request for support

We are looking for participants from institutions across the Netherlands, who are willing to share their insights and experiences of their PhD trajectories. As many current postdocs are recent alumni, they would be excellent participants for our study.

<u>Sign-up questionnaire</u>. The sign-up questionnaire collects some basic information of the PhD candidate or alumni (e.g. their field or contract type). Based on their responses, we will compose a diverse sample which will be invited to join the focus group discussions. In the attachment of this email, we have enclosed an example email that you could use as a promotional message to forward to your network.
