Engineering and Technology Institute Groningen (ENTEG)	<ul> <li>Jingxiu Xie from ENTEG has been awarded a prestigious European Research Council (ERC) Starting Grant for her groundbreaking proposal Intensified Processes for CO2 Conversion to Sustainable Synthetic Fuels.</li> </ul>		
Kapteyn Astronomical Institute	<ul> <li>The European Extremely Large Telescope (eELT), currently being built in Chile, will take highly detailed images of the universe. The design for the camera, MICADO, was approved this week with the contribution of RUG researchers.</li> </ul>		
Zernike Institute for Advanced Materials (ZIAM)	<ul> <li>Gosia Wlodarczyk-Biegun has been awarded an ERC Starting Grant. She will develop a new type of material composed of gel microspheres that can change dimensions and interact together (jam) during printing. The printed constructs will closely resemble real tissues and will be used to study breast cancer progression.</li> <li>Professor Emeritus Wim Nieuwpoort passed away on September 4, 2024, at the age of 93. Professor Nieuwpoort was a leading figure in theoretical chemistry. He served as a professor at the University of Groningen from 1968 to 1996, and was instrumental in the founding of the Materials Science Centre in 1970.</li> </ul>
