Part B. CV SUMMARY (max. 5000 characters, including spaces)

I graduated in Spanish: Language and Literature at the University of Alicante in 2015. I obtained the Master's Degree in Studies in Art, Literature and Culture at the Autonomous University of Madrid in 2016. During the academic year 2015-2016, I got a collaboration fellowship from the Ministry of Education, Culture and Sport to work with the Department of General Languages, Logic and Philosophy of Science, Theory of Literature and Comparative Literature at the Autonomous University of Madrid. In 2020, I got the Doctor's Degree with International Mention in Studies in Art, Literature and Culture at the Autonomous University of Madrid. I completed my doctoral studies in the line of Literary Theory, Comparative Literature and Rhetoric with the thesis "Reality and Fiction: history, theory and criticism of the duality", which obtained the Cum Laude distinction and the Outstanding Doctorate Award (2022). My PhD project was funded from 2018 to 2020 with a doctoral grant I obtained in competitive

concurrence. This funding was provided by the José Luis de Oriol-Catalina de Urquijo Research Promotion Foundation. I have been working as a mentor at Laspau/Global Alumni affiliated with Harvard University (September 2021 to December 2021), in the context of the programme “Innovation in Teaching”, funded by the Santander Bank. Currently, I work as mentor and Professor at U-tad: University Center of Technology and Art (Madrid).

I develop interdisciplinary research in attention to the study of the artistic and non-artistic narrative communicative activity from semiotics, pragmatics, neuroscience, cognitive-anthropology and psychology. My current research lines are the study of fiction or artistic-narrative invention from a neurocognitive perspective; the impact of artistic-narrative invention on the receiver; the research on the communicative strategies of different types of artistic and non-artistic discourses; the neurocognitive study of the construction and shaping of imaginary worlds and the theorization about interactivity in videoludic discourse. My scientific objectives in the short and medium-term are focused on the proposal of models and theoretical-explanatory concepts related to different kinds of communication in order to explain the functioning of the discursive cultural production from a neurocognitive perspective.
