You are only exempted from providing your proficiency in Dutch, if you:

- apply on the basis of a (to be obtained) IB diploma with 'Dutch A' (SL or HL);
- apply on the basis of three (to be obtained) GCE A-levels from one of the British examination boards, including an A-level Dutch;
- apply on the basis of a (to be obtained) Belgian Diploma van Algemeen Secundair Onderwijs (ASO);
- apply on the basis of a Dutch havo-diploma (in combination with a (to be obtained) HBO propaedeutic certificate or another qualification leading to vwo-equivalency);
- apply on the basis of a Dutch vwo-diploma.
